


### This Month's Birthstone

### **Hot Cocoa Pancakes**

Enjoy a warm and cozy breakfast with these festive flapjacks. **Ingredients:** 

#### o . . .

- 2 tablespoons unsweetened cocoa powder
- 1 1/2 tablespoons sugar
- 1 cup 2% or nonfat milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups ready-made pancake mix
- 1/4 cup water
- chocolate syrup
- marshmallow spread
- pancake syrup

#### **Directions:**

Heat a skillet over medium-low heat or an electric griddle to 375° F.

In a microwave-safe bowl, mix cocoa powder, sugar, milk and vanilla until well combined. Heat in the microwave for 30 seconds.

Next, combine the cocoa mixture, pancake mix and water. Stir until large lumps disappear, but do not beat or overmix the batter.

Pour slightly less than 1/4 cup batter onto the lightly greased skillet or griddle. Cook for 90 seconds, or until bubbles appear on the surface. Flip the pancake and cook it for 30 seconds more. Repeat with the remaining batter.

Top pancakes with chocolate syrup, marshmallow spread or pancake syrup.

# Winter Weather Lingo

When a winter storm is on the horizon, it's helpful to understand the words being used in the forecast. Here is a quick breakdown of some common winter weather terms: Sleet versus freezing rain. Both of these forms of precipitation begin as snow and meet a current of warm air at some point in their descent from the clouds. Sleet only partially melts, and the resulting slush refreezes and bounces on the ground, usually without sticking. Freezing rain occurs when a snowflake completely melts, but then becomes "supercooled" when it falls through a shallow layer of cold air above the ground, causing it to freeze upon contact.

Flurries, showers and squalls.
Snow flurries are light flakes that result in little to no accumulation, whereas snow showers have varying intensities of snow, with the possibility of some sticking to the ground.
Quick, windy and intense winter storms are called snow squalls, often resulting in several inches of snowfall.

Blizzard warning. This warning is issued when an area is expecting large amounts of snow accompanied by gusty winds of at least 35 mph, resulting in diminished visibility of only a quarter-mile or less.

Black ice. This ice is thin and highly transparent, making it blend in with the pavement, where it poses a danger to motorists and pedestrians.
